## Absolent Group AB's subsidiary Multi-Fan Systems secures significant contract with Building Services supplier

UK based air pollution control specialist Multi-Fan Systems, part of Absolent Group's subsidiary Filtermist Group, has secured GBP 1.4m contract to specify, install and commission a centralised local exhaust ventilation (LEV) system at a brand-new production facility at Coventry in the West Midlands.

The central system will pick up a range of contaminants including oil mist, smoke and fume from over 100 LEV systems which are being relocated from existing manufacturing sites as part of this project. The contaminated air will be condensed and then exhausted out of six centralised exhaust stacks.

"We are very pleased that Multi-Fan has secured this contract. This means our customers can access the best solution for their specific requirements. The build is the largest part of a global infrastructure investment being made by the customer and will act as the company's global headquarters with up to 1000 employees being based at the site when it opens in 2020.
